<u>Copper Coast Council Submission - South Australia's 20-year State Infrastructure</u> Strategy

Comments on the South Australia's 20-Year State Infrastructure Strategy are as follows:-

Population Growth challenges – there are some regional areas in South Australia that have population growth- for example the Copper Coast Council which encompasses the towns of Kadina, Moonta, Wallaroo and Paskeville that has significant population growth. In my view, regional areas with population growth need to have a 20 year growth plan which links provision of infrastructure (all infrastructure-hard and soft) with Federal, State, Local Governments and the community.

Each of the regional growth areas should have such a 20 year growth plan with triggers for capital facilities and service provision increase once certain population levels have been attained. This would mean additional health, police, human services and Council services once certain triggers are reached in population growth.

In relation to education the provision of tertiary hub facilities and programs in regional areas should be considered. A number of Councils or groupings of Councils are progressing individually tertiary hub facilities and courses. In some cases this would be through shared facilities with TAFE. The State Government could assist with such tertiary hub facilities and programs in regional areas, where there has been a demonstrated business case and demand for such facilities and courses.

Health services and facilities are considered to be one of the most important services for communities particularly in regional and rural areas. It is recoginised that not all specialist services can be provided in regional areas. Regional Hospitals do provide a level of specialist services with the full suite of specialist services being provided in Adelaide. However, it is important for accident and emergency services and some level of specialist services to be provided in some regional areas, particularly where there is growth.

Transport is important in regional South Australia particularly with the demise of train transport. Recognising the increase in road transport servicing agriculture and industry in regional areas is important. The maintenance and upgrade of road infrastructure is necessary to support agriculture and industry in regional areas.

I have attached information in relation to different programs, services and funding provided by Regional VIC. Consideration could be given to such programs in South Australia.


